Earth-Friendly Exhibitors' Action and Idea Fair Information and Registration Form

Northfield EARTH DAY's Earth-friendly exhibitors will bring informative/educational displays, participatory projects, products, and services that improve the sustainability of our community and planet and inspire participants to take action. The Exhibitor's Fair is an opportunity to explain your group and recruit new members. Our Earth Day event is also hosting the Cannon Valley Market to encourage more participation.

COVID Statement: Following Governor Walz's orders and to keep our community and our exhibitors safe, please review our attached COVID plan. We will require screening our exhibitors prior to the ED event. Social distancing rules will apply, so each exhibitor must ensure a 6-foot space between them and the event participants. This can be accomplished with 2 tables one in front of the other. In order to engage with participants, masks must be worn by all. Also, per our COVID plan, eating is not allowed at the event. Please bring your own water or beverage.

Where: The Action and Idea Fair will be set up on Water Street between 4th and 5th Streets and Bridge Square Street between Division and Water Streets to include Bridge Square. Space is limited; reservations are required. Exhibitors will be assigned space on a first come first served basis and must bring 2 tables.

Schedule: Registered exhibitors are welcome to set up displays at the event location between the hours of 12 pm and 12:45 pm on Sat. 4/24, and be ready to interact with interested folks from 1 pm - 4 pm. Tables and chairs are **not** provided. Please BRING YOUR OWN tables and chairs as well as your own extension cords, computers, and AV equipment. Outlets are *very limited*.

Registration: To reserve an exhibit space, complete the form below, scan it, and return it by email to the address indicated (submissions should be received by April 10). This year registration is \$15.00 for all tables. If this is prohibitive for you, please just let us know. Also, if you are one of our sponsors, this fee is waived. **We will collect the registration fee on the day of the event. Please make your check out to Northfield Area Community Solar** (Northfield Earth Day's fiscal agent).

Waste Awareness/Zero Waste Event: to avoid waste, exhibitors are asked not to use plastic or disposable give-away items.
